<p>5. General Control Investigation &amp; Objectives for the Incident (include alternatives)</p> <p><u>Goals:</u>  Reduce the number of Multnomah county residents who are vulnerable to Flu.  Reduce the number of residents who will die from flu.  Reduce the transmission of flu from currently ill persons to non-ill persons.  Appropriately use the available medical resources for the right types of clients.  Reduce community panic.</p> <p><u>Objectives:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Activate a vaccine distribution and administration system to assure THAT the first 50,000 doses (of 137,000 total) are administered to persons consistent with below priorities in the 2<sup>nd</sup> operational period. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Vaccinate HCW/HCP's and first responders (emergency workers) first (estimate 48,000 plus).</li> <li>- Vaccinate persons who are epidemiologically at highest risk (children aged 10-19, then children aged 0-4 followed by children aged 5-9).</li> <li>- Develop a system for vaccine distribution that reduces risk of theft and black marketeering and maximizes adherence to established vaccination priorities without creating undue administrative burden or use of excessive security measures.</li> <li>- Address private/ public and central/ decentralized distribution and vaccination options.</li> </ul> </li> <li>2. Develop plan to mitigate barriers for special populations to accessing and receiving vaccines, triage and treatment. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assess cultural/other barriers of vulnerable (any subgroup) populations to vaccine access and use.</li> <li>• Assess cultural/other barriers of vulnerable (any subgroup) populations to flu triage.</li> <li>• Assess cultural/other barriers of vulnerable populations to flu treatment.</li> </ul> </li> <li>3. Design and activate an ambulatory care system to screen, triage and refer individuals with flu-like symptoms who do not have established access to care by 10am Nov 2. Triage people to self-care, transmission reduction and hospitalization. Prepare for 40,000 persons over an 8 week period of time. Differentiate the probable use in each week based on the outbreak case curve.</li> <li>4. Implement community control interventions (e.g., closing/limiting operations of businesses, schools, transportation, etc.) to decrease flu spread by 8am, Nov 2.</li> <li>5. Implement a public information plan to prevent disease transmission, and seek appropriate care. Establish distribution timelines and channels that are effective in reaching all community populations. Prepare and deliver community control messages including shelter in place and social distance measures to keep kids at home and limit person to person contacts.</li> <li>6. Develop a plan and incorporate immunization for seasonal flu, and strep pneumonia (PPV23) into the overall immunization strategy, public and private.</li> <li>7. Ensure County has capacity to manage expected 300 excess deaths county wide.</li> </ol>
