<p>If involved in a life-threatening emergency first call 503-555-1234 to reach the dedicated ambulance. If this is unavailable call 911 to request an ambulance. HOWEVER, ambulance service may be overwhelmed and will respond per their procedures. For non-life threatening injuries proceed to the Mid-County Health Clinic at 12710 SE Division Street in Portland. Contact your POD or Ambulatory Assessment Point Supervisor to let them know of your injury.</p> <p>POD or Ambulatory Assessment Point supervisor will contact the Logistics Medical Unit Leader to request replacement for injured staff. POD or Ambulatory Assessment Point supervisor will also contact the Incident Safety Officer to report the incident. For non-life threatening injuries the Logistics MUL call Mid-County Health Center Clinical Staff to render treatment. For life-threatening injuries the ambulance will take the person to the nearest available hospital per 911 Dispatch instructions.</p>
