

TOPOFF 4 Recommendation

IF patient is covered in dust have them shower at home, then put on clean clothes and go a hospital

If patient is in ER have them DECON and bag their clothes per decon protocol

HAVE each patient screened with Geiger counter, have a nasal swab done and a single spot urine.

IF they are positive on the urine or nasal swab they will need further decon and admit.

IF admit > get CBC with diff, Chem 20, IV fluids

THEY will need a 24 hour urine sample collection done for CESIUM/ RADIOACTIVITY

Treatment recommendation for adults over 12 years old IS:

PRUSSIAN BLUE (RADIOGARDASE)

1 gm (TWO 500 mg capsules) taken 3 times a day for a 30 day period (6 caps a day)
